# **Operational Advice Notice** Terminal 2 – Pollutant Waste Bin (POL Bin) Consolidation

This is an updated version. Red bars have been added at the side of the document to draw the reader's attention to where changes have been made.

#### 1. Introduction

Airside Operations are looking to consolidate the amount of equipment placed in the head of stand areas across the airport to improve safety, efficiency, and housekeeping. As part of this process, it has also been identified that waste management on stands has the potential to be improved in order to ensure the segregation of waste streams.

Following on from a recent trial in Terminal 2 whereby Pollutant Waste Bins (POL Bins) were placed in three locations for consolidation, Heathrow will now continue to use these new locations and the bins will not return to the Head of Stand equipment areas.

On the following two pages, Drawing A, Drawing B and Drawing C illustrate three new centralised disposal locations (highlighted RED) in place in Terminal 2.

Heathrow will be looking to further develop this consolidation throughout 2024 with new locations being set up in other Terminal areas. Any further change and new locations will be communicated via an update to this Operational Advice Notice.


