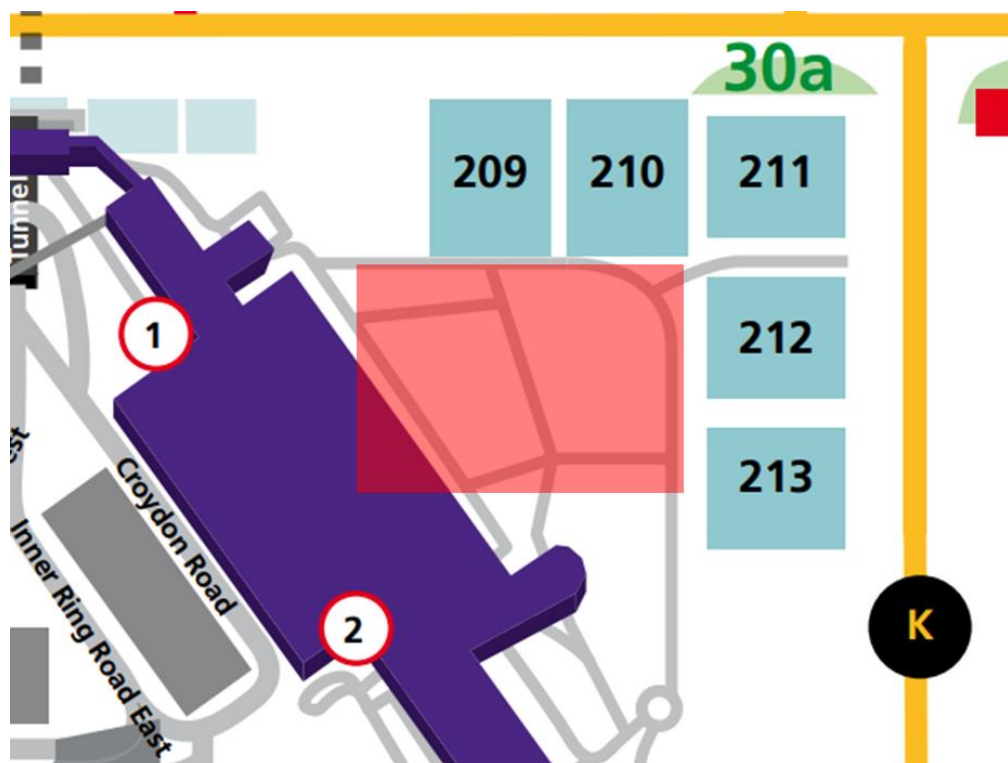

1. Introduction

This Operational Advice Notice has been written to give all airside users notice of road alterations that are being made around the Terminal 2 Baggage Recovery Facility (formerly Iridium Triangle).

In order to allow Costain to progress, further construction areas are required along the roadway. **Drawing A** on the following page (shows in **RED**) indicates the parts of road which will be closed, and illustrates the planned traffic routes available for road users. These alterations will take place progressively during operational hours on **28th May 2024**.
