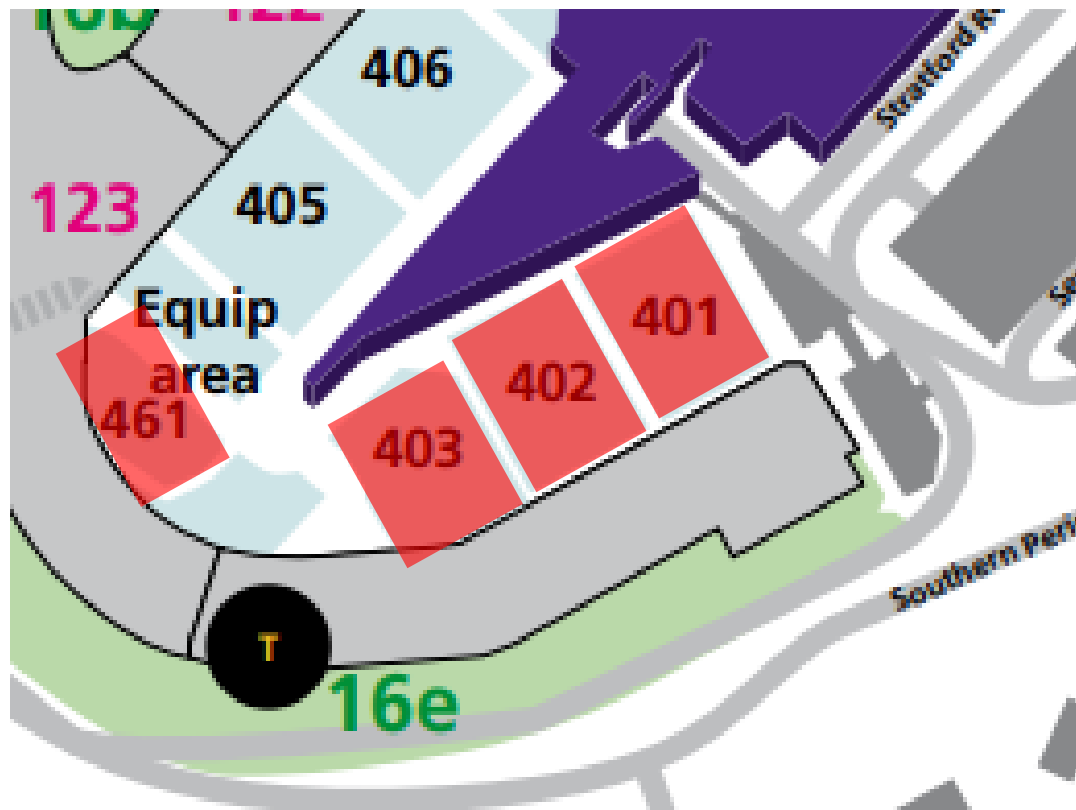

1. Introduction

This Operational Advice Notice (OAN) is issued to notify the airport community about the upcoming FEGP maintenance works to investigate issue of the nuisance tripping occurring in Terminal 4. These works will occur **from 2230 hours on 25th July 2024 to 0400 hours on 26th July 2024**. As a result, the FEGP systems of **Stands 401 – 403 and 461** will be temporarily unavailable during the above mentioned period.

The stands that will be impacted by these works have been distinctly marked in red below.



2. Safety Procedures

- 2.1 All FEGPs must be removed from aircraft for the duration of the works.
- 2.2 All systems will be available and ready for the start of business outside of the above mentioned periods.
