1. Introduction

From Monday 29th July 2024 to Wednesday 31st July 2024 (3 nights), the Fourth Avenue which runs from the Flight Connections bus stop at Terminal 4 round the airfield to CP24A will be closed, as well as the road that runs adjacent to Stand 401 (shown in red above). The hours of work will be from 22:30 to 04:30.


The works being carried out is a GPR (Ground Penetrating Radar) survey of the roadway as well as pit lifting and underground service tracing.

Traffic from CP24 and CP24A can still access Terminal 4 by using the unmanned crossing across Tango Taxiway. The exit at CP24 will also remain open.

2. Safety Procedures

Sunbelt (on behalf of Mace) will be setting up diversion road signage along the Tunnel Link Road to divert the traffic along Beacon Road North to Terminal 4 via the Tango roundabout.

Then the road closure will be set up to prevent traffic accessing the work area. Please see below road map:



































This alternative route will mean road users will use an airside uncontrolled taxiway crossing. Users are reminded to familiarise themselves with the rules and restrictions of use of uncontrolled taxiway crossings.
